School Annual Report

Academic Achievements: All the exams (four assessments including two periodic tests, Half Yearly exams and Annual exams for grade 1 to 9 & 11 and three Periodic Tests and three pre boards for grade 10 & 12) were held. Final exams were conducted offline and online both as the school was physically opened that time. Inter House competitions were conducted online. The hardcopies and softcopies of all the exams were submitted to the Exam Cell. 100% results were achieved in all grades. All the CBSE activities and competitions were conducted as per the directions of CBSE. To celebrate the Republic Day, the following competitions for students (on mygov.in portal during the period 20th January to 30th January 2021) were conducted:

1. Quiz competition
2. Essay writing competition
3. Poetry Writing Competition Mind Wars Olympiad 2020, a GK Olympiad is conducted for students

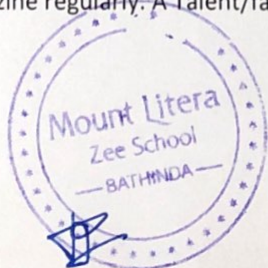
Efforts for Environmental Education : All the days were celebrated online and umpteen activities were conducted to help students understand the importance of these days. All the CBSE activities and competitions were conducted. On 6 February 2020, A Guest lecture/Seminar on COVID19 SAFETY was conducted in which Dr Pradeep Goyal, PEDIATRICIAN AND NEONATOLOGIST MBBS,DCH,DNB(Paediatrics) was invited to spread awareness.

Sports Achievements: Different sport activities were conducted in online sessions especially Yoga, aerobics and fitness exercises. Students were helped to learn the benefits of being physically active.

Club Activities and Celebrations: All the religious festivals such as Christmas, Diwali along with National and International days like International Women's Day were celebrated online. Many guests were also invited to address the parents and students of the school. However, no physical field trip could be organized due to the current situation. But virtual trips were arranged for the students.

School Enrichment Remedial Programmes: ERP and HRP were organized for the needy students to fill the gap. Many worksheets are sent to kids to enrich their knowledge. In the physical school, a special period is assigned for them to give them extra practice. They are given extra periods during the assembly time. Comparatively simpler question papers are made for them to assess their knowledge. Gradually they are brought up to the level of other students. Still if needed, counsellor's session is arranged for the students and their parents.

Innovative Ideas and school mega-events: Virtual Art and Craft exhibition was held on the culmination day of summer camp where the students displayed all the art and craft work done by them. To encourage students for creative writing, their write ups are published in the monthly school magazine regularly. A Talent/fashion show was showcased by students of grade 1 to 10 on



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26-2-21, the final round of FASHION SHOW was conducted offline in the school. All the shortlisted participants who took part in the first round (first round was conducted on 15-5-2020) participated in it. Poster making competition was also arranged on National Science Day. A webinar on NEP was conducted for teachers and parents.

PTA Activities: We have a strong PTA. Many different meetings/ activities were conducted which required parents' participation.

Some doctor parents were given an opportunity to address the students to guide them how to keep them healthy and fit.

PTMs were conducted from time to time where parents' concerns were heard and resolved.
